Dissertation defense will be scheduled the week of **May 19, 2009**. Binding should not be done until approval by the defense committee.

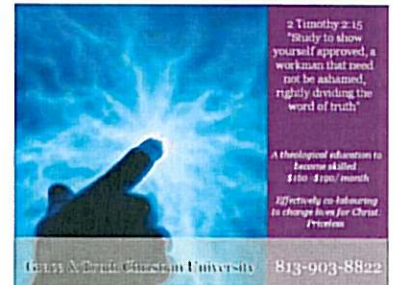
